We have several varieties of Hard and Softneck Garlic available for eating (table stock) and planting (seed stock). The seed stock is generally larger than the table stock and inspected to be free of disease. All the varieties we sell have performed well at our farm and proven to be winter hardy. Prices are for garlic picked up at the farm or the Ithaca Farmers Market.

Rocamboles- We have grown this hardneck type for the last 5 years with good consistent results. \$6.00/lb (table stock) or \$8.00/ lb (seed stock)

German White- Known for its very large cloves. Each head has only 4-6 cloves each. If you don't like peeling small cloves then this is the variety for you. \$8.00/ lb (table and seed stock)

“Kingbird” softneck- This is an unknown variety of a softneck that is good for braiding and stores well. Unlike many softnecks that don't perform well in this area, this variety does

well and produces large heads. \$6.00/lb (table stock) or \$8.00/lb (seed stock)
